<u>The Unifor Family Education Program is funded by the National Union.</u> There is no cost to your local, and you are NOT required to have PEL in your collective agreement in order to apply or send members to this program.

This year we are holding two (2) English language sessions:

Summer 2022 Dates:

Session 1 – Sunday, July 3rd through Sunday, July 10th Session 2 – Sunday, August 14th through Sunday, August 21st

Applications must be received in our office no later than <u>Friday, April</u> 22nd, 2022.

Colour posters have been included with this letter. It includes space for you to write in your Local Union contact person and their contact information. *Please find a way to get these information posters displayed in all your workplaces.*

We want to restate our practice of first considering families who have never had the opportunity to attend the Family Education Program. Members are not eligible if they have attended within the last 7 years. The program is open to all Unifor members and their *immediate* family. For the purpose of the program, *immediate* family is spouse/partner and dependent children (up to and including age 18 only). THIS <u>DOES</u> NOT INCLUDE GRANDCHILDREN, NIECES, NEPHEWS, ETC.

We also want to make a special appeal to achieve our Unifor goal of equity when it comes to membership access to this important education program.

Unifor Family Education Program

What is the Unifor Family Education Program?

This is a unique program where members and their families learn about our Union and about issues facing Canadian families.

<u>ADULTS</u> will discuss current economic and social issues from a worker's viewpoint, as well as the history, structure and policies of our Union. We will also have a number of excellent guest speakers on topics that touch the lives of workers every day: changing society, globalization, our health care system, coalition building, human rights and equality issues, to name a few.

All sessions are held in a comfortable and very informal setting.

<u>TEENS – 13 to 18 years</u>, will be involved in their own program that will be geared to the concerns and issues of their age group. Again, the setting for their discussions is informal and relaxed.

<u>CHILDREN – 4 to 12 years</u> will have a program supervised by trained recreation counsellors with activities ranging from arts and crafts to games and sports.

<u>CHILDREN – infants to age 3</u> will be cared for in the day-nursery, complete with infant daycare and preschool facilities - including sleeping accommodation, enclosed playground and qualified staff. Please note that infants must be enrolled in child care and will not attend the classroom sessions with parents.


Will there be family time?

Discussions in class generally run from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Evenings are free to enjoy an array of organized and unorganized recreation activities.

Eligibility Requirements and Instructions



You do not require Paid Education Leave [PEL] in your contract.

You are <u>NOT eligible</u> to apply for the Family Education Program if you have attended within the last 7 years.

Unifor will provide, free of charge, food and lodging to each participant (and family member) during your stay at the Education Centre.

Each participant must contribute their time (vacation, personal leave, etc.). <u>NO LOST</u>

TIME, PER DIEM OR MILEAGE WILL BE PAID.

The program runs from Sunday dinner through to the following Sunday at approximately 11:00 am. <u>Early departures from the program cannot be accommodated.</u> Please ensure you can attend the entire program before applying.

Plane tickets will be provided by the National Union (if you are traveling more than 500 kilometers one way, and choose to fly rather than drive).

Those requiring an overnight stay while travelling to and from the Centre, will be provided with hotel accommodations. <u>Costs for meals during this overnight stay are your responsibility.</u>
